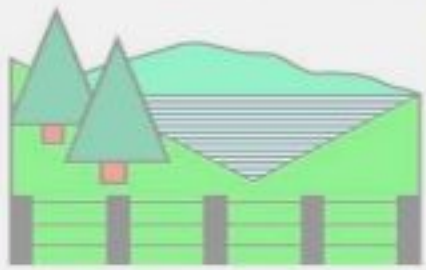

Ko taku reo taku ohooho, ko taku reo taku mapihi mauria

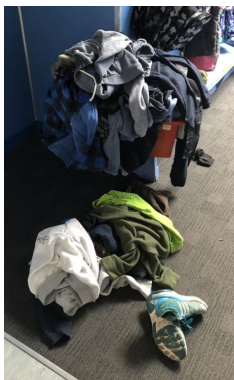
My language is my awakening, my language is the window to my soul
