Thank you letter

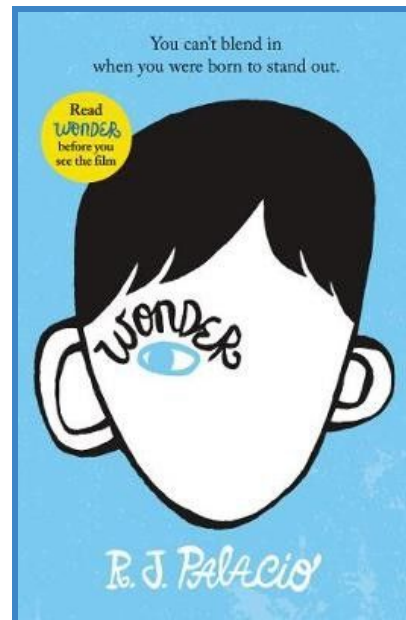

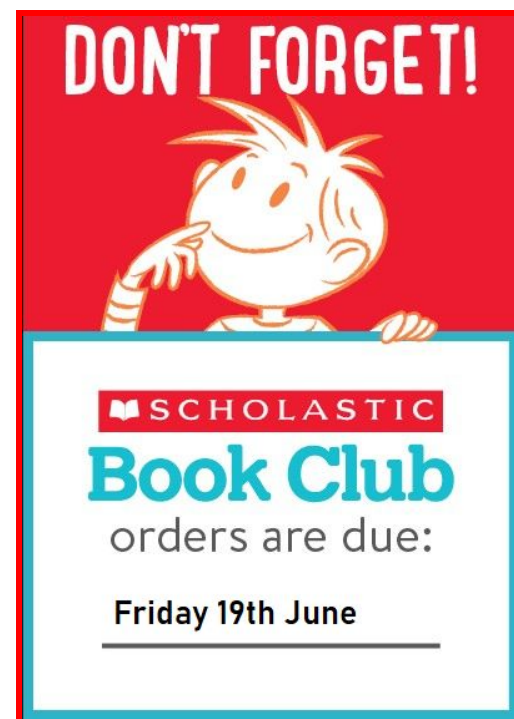
