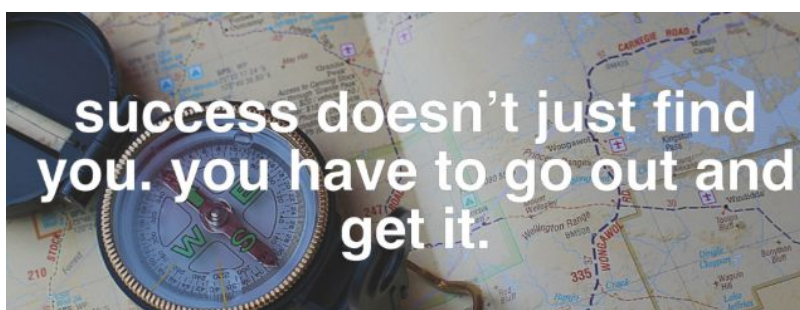

Principal's Message

Nga mihi mahana ki a koutou,
What a superb athletics day. It was a day full of smiles, nerves, encouragement and competition. Well done to all of our tamariki getting out there and being part of our annual athletics. Congratulations to Hulme House who won the house competition for most points. A big thanks to Whaea Deb for her organisation and teachers, parents and ex-students who ran or helped out at events throughout the day. Children who are aged 7 to 13yr (at Oct 14th 2019) and placed first or second in an event are eligible to enter the cluster athletics. Whaea Deb will put together a notice to go out tomorrow. We will require parent support with transport and running the sprints with the Cluster athletics being held at Reporoa College this year.

This Friday we have a Collaborative Children's Conference for students in years 5-8. This is a community of learning event being held to provide a forum for children to lead learning and to learn from each other. Children from across our 6 schools (Galatea, Mihi, Broadlands, Reporoa Primary, Reporoa College and Lake Rerewhakaaitu) will take part in 2 workshops run by some of the students from each school. There will also be keynote speakers throughout the day - one being Fisher Wang who recently became the youngest person to be elected on to Lake District Council.

Year 5-8 students will be travelling to Reporoa via bus at 9am and return at approximately 2.30 depending on the weather. There is the opportunity to go for a swim if the weather permits, so kids - do pack your togs and towel. The college pool is heated. A sausage sizzle and fruit will be provided for lunch. All children from Years 5-8 are able to attend and if they are not running a workshop, they will have signed up to attend one or two. If you do not want your child to attend please send a note or mail the teacher indicating this and they can stay at school in room 1 or 2.

I would like to acknowledge Vicki Arnott. Vicki has resigned from her teaching position and will finish at the end of the 2019 school year. Vicki has been teaching at the school for over 20 years and contributed hugely to the development of young people in our community.
