Last weeks absentees: Rakau 78% attendance Mahuri 90% attendance Tupu 72.7% attendance




We have one student with 100% attendance for the year to date. Excellent effort to students and their whanau for ensuring your tamariki are attending school each day.


♥Caught being Awesome
