We try to visit all schools at least monthly but will go as needed, for instance if there is a head lice outbreak and schools want us to get involved. We can also support any health initiatives such as handwashing/ nose-blowing and all those basics to avoid spreading bugs. We also do puberty talks for the senior students, Year 6 and above.
